



Frequently Asked Questions

1. Do I need to book a ticket in advance?

No, this is a drop-in event, however, if the kitchen is busy there may be a wait before you can enter.

2. Is parking available?

No there is no parking available. There is a car park approximately a 5-7 minutes walk away from Cowdray Ruins on North Street, Midhurst, and further afield at Grange Road; please see: <https://www.chichester.gov.uk/carparks#Ruralandcoastalcarparks>

3. Are refreshments available?

Refreshments are not available on site, the Cowdray Farm Shop and Café are approximately a 7 minute walk away and there are facilities in Midhurst Town Centre.

4. Will this event be suitable for pushchairs and wheelchairs?

There is a step up to the Tudor Kitchen and quite a tight turning circle to get into the kitchen which may preclude entry for both wheelchairs and pushchairs.

5. Where will the event take place?

The event takes place in the Tudor Kitchen - there is no access to the rest of Cowdray Ruins.

6. Are toilets available?

The nearest toilets are located at North Street Car Park.

7. Are dogs allowed on site?

Dogs are not permitted on site with the exception of Assistance Dogs.
