Local Rules



1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

A ball is out of bounds when:

- a. it is lying beyond a fence or hedge bounding the golf course. This includes to the left of the 1st and 2nd holes and to the right of the 10th, 12th and 13th holes.
- b. it is lying beyond any area defined by white posts. In the interest of safety, golf balls must not be retrieved from the driving range adjacent to the 1st hole.

2. Abnormal Course Conditions including Ground Under Repair (Rule 16.1)

Players may take relief under rule 16.1 for animal droppings, animal damage, tyre ruts made by course machinery etc.

3. Fixed Sprinkler Heads (Rule 16.1a)

In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, when a ball lies in the general area, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within

two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (Exception - There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

4. Paths and Roads (Rule 16.1)

All roads and paths on the course, even if not artificially surfaced, are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief can be taken under Rule 16.1. This includes the path to the right of the 16th green.

5. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16.1)

The following are immovable obstructions: Irrigation covers, fixed course furniture, the bell support on the 2nd hole, wooden sleeper rails, well head on the 18th hole, tree support on the 5th hole, drainage plugs on the 15th and 16th greens and all marker posts. Free relief can be taken under Rule 16.1b.

6. 16th Hole. Please play to flag on the right of this shared green.

7. Protection of Young Trees: Young trees are identified with a stake in the ground either attached or adjacent, are no play zones. If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take free relief under Rule 16.1f.

All Golfers: All golfers must repair pitch marks on greens, replace all divots and rake bunkers after play, please leave rakes in the bunkers after use. Pace of play must also be adhered to, any match/game losing one clear hole on the game in front **MUST** call through the game behind. These are the minimum requirement for all golfers.

Distance Markers: Both the yellow 150 yard posts and sprinkler heads denote yardage to the centre of the green.

Winter Golf: Please take extra care during the winter when faced with frost, steps and steep banks. Please keep buggies to the designated tracks when instructed.
