Our team of judges will include experts from the Estate and beyond including Ben Jupp Cowdray's Executive Chef, floral designer Milli Proust and Stefano Cerea, Cowdray Farm Shop Pastry Chef.



## COMPETITION CATEGORIES

### OPEN TO ALL AGES

*\*all cooking / baking must be to your own recipe.*

- Any type of homemade QUICHE *\*the quiche will be judged on appearance, taste and ingredients used*
- One VICTORIA SPONGE *\*the Victoria Sponge will be judged on appearance, taste and texture*
- One DECORATED CAKE *\*the decorated cake will be judged on its appearance (icing / detail / colour) and bake. A slice will be cut so that the layering can be viewed*
- One LOAF OF BREAD of any kind *\*the loaf will be judged on the appearance and texture*
- Jar of any HOMEMADE MARMALADE OR FRUIT JAM *\*judged on taste*
- Jar of any HOMEMADE CHUTNEY OR PICKLE *\*judged on taste*
- MIXED CUT FLOWERS – *any varieties in one jar \*maximum diameter 7cm / standard jam jar*
- Most UNUSUALLY SHAPED FRUIT OR VEGETABLE

### CHILDREN

*Up to 13 years of age*

- Best POEM / STORY ABOUT MIDHURST *\*limited to 100 words*
- Best PIECE OF ART (2D OR 3D) OF A POLO PONY *\*maximum of A3 size / 20cm (cubed)*

## COMPETITION RULES

- Only those attending Midhurst Town Cup may compete.
- Submit your entry form online [www.cowdray.co.uk/produce-competition](http://www.cowdray.co.uk/produce-competition) or via email before 28th June, Email: [marketing@cowdray.co.uk](mailto:marketing@cowdray.co.uk). There is no charge for entering.
- Entries for each class are limited and may close ahead of time if over subscribed.
- All vegetables and flowers must be grown in the exhibitor's own garden or allotment.
- Exhibits can be brought in and arranged between 10:00 - 11.00am on the day of the show. Please make sure your name is written on the card with your exhibit (Cards will be provided). Judging will take place at 12pm
- All vegetables must be cleaned before exhibiting. Exhibitors must provide their own jar for the flower category and their own plate / stand for baked goods.
- The quantity and type of and of the categories shall correspond with the number indicated in the individual classes, and shall be limited to one in all of the other categories.
- The decision of the judges shall final, but the Show sub-committee will decide on any other points in dispute.
- Rosettes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each class
- Please collect your exhibits at the end of the show / after the prize giving has taken place
