## COWDRAY

Cowdray covers 16,000 acres and is entirely set within the South Downs National Park. From the chalk grasslands on the South Downs to the River Rother, heathlands, woodland, and more, we have a diverse mix of habitats with a range of nature recovery projects well underway.

Our focus is on habitat management and creation – “Build it, and they will come.” We aim to enhance and create habitats across the estate to support all species, from the smallest soil microorganisms to insects and birds. They are all interconnected, and one cannot thrive without the other - including us.

However, some species need a little more help, and we have specific programmes to support endangered species such as the pearl-bordered fritillary butterfly and the honey buzzard.





## THE OPPORTUNITY

We are now inviting investment to drive forward nature recovery at Cowdray.

### Current projects include:

- Water meadow and river restoration
- Enhancement of wildlife corridors through our wild edges, hedges, and ponds plan
- Water quality protection through catchment-wide initiatives
- Tree planting – not just for greenhouse gas removal, but for all the benefits trees provide, such as improved air quality, biodiversity, and water quality
- Increasing access to, and engagement with, the environment
